## Phrasal Verb Group "Look"

### 1. To look on

**Meaning** = to consider / to perceive

#### Example 1:

Q: How do you look on the people from Madrid?

A: I look on the people from Madrid as well educated

#### Example 2:

My parents look on my clothes as inappropriate

### 2. To look forward to

**Meaning** = to be excited about (something)/ to be motivated about (something)

#### Example 1:

Q: What are you looking forward to?

A: I'm really looking forward to going on holiday?

#### Example 2:

I am looking forward to seeing you (business emails)

#### Example 3:

I am looking forward to working with you (business emails)

## Phrasal Verb Group "Look"

### 3. To look into

**Meaning** = research/ examine/ investigate

#### Example 1:

I will look into it as soon as possible

#### Example 2:

The detective is looking into the murder

### 4. To look through

**Meaning** = to browse / to take a quick look

#### Example 1:

To look through a magazine

#### Example 2:

Could you look through the company files and find last year's sales report?

### 5. To look after

**Meaning 1** = to take care for (something/someone)

#### Example 1:

Look after yourself

#### Example 2:

I look after my kids

### 5. To look after

**Meaning 2** = to take responsibility for

#### Example 1:

Could you look after the report?

#### Example 2:

Could you look after sending that email?

### 6. To look back on

**Meaning** = to remember / to recall

#### Example 1:

Q: When you look back on your school life, how do you feel?

A: I don't really like to look back on my school life because I get a bit sad

#### Example 2:

I don't really like to look back

#### Example 3:

Don't look back in anger (a song by Oasis:

**Meaning** = to search for

#### Example 1:

Are you looking for a job?

#### Example 2:

To look for your keys

### 8. To look at

**Meaning** = to pay attention to (something)

#### Example 1:

I am looking at you

I am looking at the computer

#### Example 2:

Look at that car!

### 9. To look up

**Meaning** = to find information about something

#### Example 1:

Look it up

Look it up on Google

#### Example 2:

Look up the answer on the internet
